## A RESOLUTION

Respectfully requesting the President and the Secretary of the Department of Human Resources to investigate the living conditions of Federated States of Micronesia citizens in Guam.

- 1 WHEREAS, many citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia
- 2 live and work in Guam; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the Congress has received reports that some of the
- 4 citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia in Guam live in
- 5 dangerous, unsanitary and substandard housing; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the Cable News Network (CNN) recently aired a program
- 7 about poor living conditions of foreign workers in Guam; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia
- 9 has little information about the living status of its citizens in
- 10 Guam; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia
- 12 wishes to protect the health and safety of its citizens living
- 13 abroad; now, therefore,
- 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventh Congress of the Federated States
- 15 of Micronesia, Third Regular Session, 1992, that the Congress hereby
- 16 respectfully requests the President of the Federated States of
- 17 Micronesia and the Secretary of the Department of Human Resources to
- 18 take immediate steps to investigate the living conditions of the
- 19 citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia living in Guam; and
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that they report both their findings and,
- 21 if necessary, proposed curative actions to the Congress within 60
- 22 days of receipt of this resolution; and
