## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$110,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, for the purpose of funding certain public projects in the State of Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. The sum of \$110,000, or so much thereof as may be
2	necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
3	Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September
4	30, 1994, for the purpose of funding certain public projects in
5	Kosrae State.
6	Section 2. The sum appropriated under section 1 of this act
7	shall be apportioned as follows:
8	(1) Kosrae Family Food Production
9	and Nutrition (KFFPN)
10	(2) Kosrae Community Action Programs
11	(KCAP)
12	(3) Kosrae V6AJ Radio Broadcast Station 22,000
13	(4) Vehicle for Farmers Cooperative
14	Association
15	(5) Production & Marketing for Division
16	of Department of Conservation and Development 7,000
17	(6) Private local markets
18	Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
19	allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance
20	with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
21	Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be the Governor of the
22	State of Kosrae, who shall be responsible for ensuring that these
23	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
24	the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are
25	incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the

1 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of

2 September 30, 1996.

3 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the

4 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming

5 law without such approval.
