A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 2-34, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 2-44, 3-12, 3-35, 3-50, 4-79, 5-11, 6-106, 8-10 and 8-36, to modify the use of funds previously appropriated therein for certain public projects in the Mortlocks, Chuuk State; by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 3-17, 4-15, 5-26, 6-106, 7-12 and 8-12, for the purpose of changing the allottee of funds appropriated therein; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 2-34, as amended by
- 2 Public Laws Nos. 2-44, 3-12, 3-35, 3-50, 4-79, 5-11, 6-106, 8-10 and
- 3 8-36, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

7	ending September 30, 1982, for the purpose of funding

8	the respective areas of the State of Truk Chuuk; PROVIDED,
9	however, that the allottee of the funds appropriated under
10	subsection (2) of section 1 of this act shall be the Faichuk
11	PWP Development Authority, ≉≠¢ that the allottee of the funds
12	appropriated under subsection (4) of section 1 of this act
13	shall be the Governor of Chuuk State, and that the allottee
14	of the funds appropriated under subsection (5) of section 1
15	of this act shall be the Lower Mortlocks Development
16	Authority."
17	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
18	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
19	law without such approval.
