A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 53 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-120, 6-111, 7-118, 7-119 and 7-120, by adding new sections 811 and 812 to limit the amount of time the Social Security Administration may take to complete claimants' files and determine benefits claims, and to require spoken and written information to be given to claimants on their rights and responsibilities, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Title 53 of the Code of the Federated States of Micro-
- 2 nesia is hereby further amended by adding a new section 811 of chapter
- 3 8 to read as follows:

4 "Section 811. Time limits.

benefits claims, a file must be completed within 45 days of
a claimant's application for Social Security benefits at any
Social Security office within the Federated States of
Micronesia. It is the responsibility of the claimant to
cooperate with the Social Security Administration by
providing information and documentation whenever possible.
It is the responsibility of the Social Security Administra-
tion to obtain the required documents from other sources,
and to conduct any investigation needed to complete the file
within this 45-day time limit. In extraordinary
circumstances such as natural disasters, a 30-day extension
of time to complete a file may be granted to the Adminis-
trator or the Administrator's designee by the Board, but in
no case may a pending file take longer than 75 days to
complete. After the 45-day time limit, or 75 days if an
extension was properly granted, any missing documents or
evidence from the file shall be construed in favor of the
claimant, unless the claimant has unjustifiably refused to
provide information to the Social Security Administration,
or when an unreasonable delay is primarily caused by the

2	Section 3. This act shall take effect 30 days after becoming
3	law.
4	Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
5	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
