## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 54 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by adding a new section 119 for the purpose of requiring taxpayer identification numbers, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Title 54 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia is hereby further amended by adding a new section 119 to read as follows:
- 4 "Section 119. Taxpayer identification numbers.
- (1) Every taxpayer is required to obtain a taxpayer

  identification number and to include that number on all

  returns or other communications from the taxpayer to the

  Department of Finance.
  - registered with the Federated States of Micronesia
    Social Security Administration, the taxpayer
    identification number shall be that taxpayer's employee
    or employer social security account number. For any
    other taxpayer, the Social Security Administration shall
    issue an employer social security account number
    (whether or not that taxpayer is an employer for social
    security purposes) within one month after the taxpayer
    has applied for same in writing, and thereafter said
    social security account number shall be that taxpayer's
    tax identification number.
    - (3) It is the responsibility of each existing taxpayer who lacks a taxpayer identification number to apply for one within three months after this section 119 becomes law.
      - (4) After this section 119 has been law for four



1	months, no person or other entity shall commence or
2	continue any business, commerce, importing, profession,
3	occupation, employment, or other activity which is
4	taxable by the National Government unless such person or
5	entity shall have first obtained a taxpayer
6	identification number. The Secretary is authorized to
7	provide for the uniform assessment of fines for
8	violation of this subsection in an amount not to exceed
9	\$250 for each month or fraction thereof that the
10	violation exists.
11	(5) After this section 119 has been law for four
12	months, each department, office, administration,
13	authority, branch, bureau, instrumentality, public
14	corporation, and other arm (collectively 'agency') of
15	the National Government shall be required, and each
16	agency of any State or local government is encouraged,
17	to require inclusion of taxpayer identification numbers
18	on all permits or licenses of any sort, including
19	extensions or renewals thereof, issued to a taxpayer by
20	that agency."
21	Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
22	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
23	becoming law without such approval.
