## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 52 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-21, 6-114, 7-16, 7-90, and 7-121, by amending section 142 to further limit outside employment by foreign employees of the National Government, and for other purposes.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 142 of title 52 of the Code of the
- 2 Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as
- 3 follows:

- 4 "Section 142. <u>Outside employment</u>.
- No employee subject to the provisions of this 5 6 chapter shall engage in any outside employment or other 7 outside activity which is not compatible with the full 8 and proper discharge of the responsibilities of his 9 position or is otherwise prohibited by law. It shall be 10 deemed incompatible with such discharge of 11 responsibilities for any such employee to accept any 12 fee, compensation, gift, payment of expenses, or any 13 other thing of monetary value in circumstances such that acceptance may result in, or create the appearance of 14 15 resulting in:
  - (a) use of public office for private gain;
- 17 (b) an undertaking to give preferential 18 treatment to any person;
  - (c) impeding Government efficiency or economy;
- 20 (d) any loss of complete independence or 21 impartiality;
- 22 (e) the making of a Government decision 23 outside official channels; or
- 24 (f) any adverse effect on the confidence of 25 the public in the integrity of the Government.

(2) No employee subject to the provisions of this chapter shall receive compensation or anything of monetary value, other than that to which he is duly entitled from the Government, for the performance of any activity during his service as such employee and within the scope of his official responsibilities.

(3) No full-time employee who is neither a citizen nor a national of the Federated States of Micronesia and whose primary duty station is within the Federated States of Micronesia shall hold any other employment or engage in any business in the Federated States of Micronesia; PROVIDED, however, that the foregoing shall not apply in the case of other employment where the National Government is the employer, in the case of any business which does not require a permit under chapter 2 of title 32 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (the Foreign Investment Act), or in the case of other employment or any business as to which the Director of Administrative Services has, upon application of the employee, made a specific determination that the national interest will be served thereby. For purposes of this subsection, the 'Federated States of Micronesia' includes its territorial sea and exclusive economic zone, and 'employee' shall include any employee who is subject to

4	Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
5	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
6	becoming law without such approval.
