The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (4)(m) and (4)(o) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Malem Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(p) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Utwe Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(q) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Tafunsak Municipal Government. The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse."
