

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79 and 8-116, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79 and 8-116, for the purpose of reappropriating certain funds, and by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79 and 8-116, for the purpose of designating the allottees of funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79 and 8-116, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The funds appropriated under section 1 of this act shall be apportioned as follows:

13	Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public	
14	Laws Nos. 8-79 and 8-116, is hereby further amended to read as follows:	
15	"Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be	
16	allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in	
17	accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited	
18	to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of	
19	the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(a) of section 2	
20	of this act shall be the PWP Development Authority. The	
21	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections	
22	(1)(b)(i), (1)(b)(ii), (1)(b)(iii) and (1)(b)(iv) of	
23	section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Fono.. The	
24	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections	
25	(1)(b)(v), (1)(b)(vi) and (1)(b)(vii) of section 2 of this	

1 act shall be the Mayor of Pis-Paneu. The allottee of the
2 funds appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(viii),
3 (1)(b)(x), (1)(b)(xi), and (1)(b)(xvii) of section 2 of
4 this act shall be the Mayor of Weno. The allottee of the
5 funds appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(ix),
6 (1)(b)(xii), (1)(b)(xiii), (1)(b)(xiv), (1)(b)(xv),
7 (1)(b)(xvi), and (1)(b)(xviii) of section 2 of this act
8 shall be the Weno Projects Coordinator. The allottee of
9 the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(c) of section 2
10 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
11 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
12 subsection (1)(d) of section 2 of this act shall be the
13 Lower Mortlocks Development Authority. The allottee of the
14 funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(i), (1)(e)(ii)
15 and (1)(e)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the
16 Executive Director of the Hall Development Authority. The
17 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
18 (1)(e)(iv), (1)(e)(v) and (1)(e)(vi) of section 2 of this
19 act shall be the Weito Development Authority. The allottee
20 of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(vii),
21 (1)(e)(viii), (1)(e)(ix), (1)(e)(x), (1)(e)(xi) ~~and~~
22 ~~(1)(e)(xii)~~, (1)(e)(xii), and (1)(e)(xiii) of section 2 of
23 this act shall be the Pattiw Development Authority. The
24 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
25 (1)(f)(i) and (1)(f)(ii) of section 2 of this act shall be

1 the Executive Director of COCA. The allottee of the funds
2 appropriated under subsections (1)(f)(iii), (1)(f)(iv) and
3 (1)(f)(v) of section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of
4 the State of Chuuk. The allottee of the funds appropriated
5 under subsection (1)(f)(vi) of section 2 of this act shall
6 be the Lower Mortlocks Development Authority. The allottee
7 of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(i) of
8 section 2 of this act shall be the Luhkenkolwof of
9 Sapwuafik. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
10 subsection (2)(a)(ii) of section 2 of this act shall be the
11 Chief Magistrate of Nukuoro. The allottee of the funds
12 appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(iii) of section 2 of
13 this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Kapingamarangi.
14 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
15 (2)(a)(iv) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of
16 Kolonia Town. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
17 subsections (2)(a)(v)a), (2)(a)(v)b) and 2(a)(v)i) of
18 section 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of
19 Sokehs. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
20 subsections (2)(b), (2)(c), (2)(e), (2)(f), (4)(b), (4)(c),
21 (4)(d), (4)(e), (4)(f), (4)(g), (4)(h), (4)(i), (4)(j) and
22 (4)(k) of section 2 of this act shall be the President of
23 the Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee of funds
24 appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(v)c) of section 2 of
25 this act shall be


1 the Pohnpei Utility Corporation. The allottee of funds
2 appropriated under subsection (2)(d) of section 2 of this
3 act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority. The
4 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 3 of
5 section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of
6 Yap or his designee. The allottee of the funds
7 appropriated under subsection (4)(a) of section 2 of this
8 act shall be the Chairman of the Kosrae Sports Council.
9 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
10 (4)(l) and (4)(n) of section 2 of this act shall be the
11 Mayor of the Lelu Municipal Government. The allottee of
12 the funds appropriated under subsections (4)(m) and (4)(o)
13 of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Malem
14 Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds
15 appropriated under subsection (4)(p) of section 2 of this
16 act shall be the Mayor of the Utwe Municipal Government.
17 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
18 (4)(q) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the
19 Tafunsak Municipal Government. The allottees shall be
20 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much
21 thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the
22 purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are
23 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority
24 of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act
25 shall not lapse."
