

AN ACT

PRESIDENTIAL COMM. NO. 8-53
FSM CONGRESS

To further amend Public Law No. 7-78, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 7-80, 7-111, 7-113, 7-127 and 7-129, by amending sections 1, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10, 12, 14, and 15 to appropriate the sum of \$1,676,281 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1993, as supplemental funding for the executive branch, judicial branch, College of Micronesia-FSM, agencies of the National Government, marine surveillance program, and special programs, grants, subsidies, and contributions; to reduce the funds deemed to come from the capital account of the Compact of Free Association; to authorize two more positions in the Department of Resources and Development; to authorize one more position in the Department of Finance; to transfer funds within the Office of the Public Auditor; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 7-78, as amended by Public Law



(2) The number of positions authorized applies individually to each of the departments and offices of the executive and legislative branches, the National judiciary, the Public Auditor, and to the agencies as provided in subsection (1) of this section, except that the President may transfer up to 12 positions between the departments and offices of the executive branch. This authorization of positions covers all permanent employees and all contract personnel whose employment extends for more than 90 days, regardless of the source of funds for such positions. No funds may be expended for unbudgeted positions."
