AN ACT

PRESIDENTIAL COMM. NO. FSM CONGRESS

To further amend Public Law No. 7-78, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 7-80, 7-111, 7-113, 7-127 and 7-129, by amending sections 1, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10, 12, 14, and 15 to appropriate the sum of \$1,676,281 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1993, as supplemental funding for the executive branch, judicial branch, College of Micronesia-FSM, agencies of the National Government, marine surveillance program, and special programs, grants, subsidies, and contributions; to reduce the funds deemed to come from the capital account of the Compact of Free Association; to authorize two more positions in the Department of Resources and Development; to authorize one more position in the Department of Finance; to transfer funds within the Office of the Public Auditor; and for other purposes.
