AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 8-75, which appropriated the sum of \$10,100,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, to fund public projects in the four States, by amending section 2 to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, by amending section 3 to change and specify the allottees of funds, and for other purposes.

Agency. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
subsections (2)(b), (4)(b), (4)(c), (4)(d), (4)(e), (4)(f),
(4)(g), $(4)(h)$, $(4)(i)$, $(4)(j)$ and $(4)(k)$ of section 2 of this
act shall be the President of the Federated States of
Micronesia. The allottee of the funds appropriated under

subsection (4)(a) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chairman
of the Kosrae Sports Council. The allottee of the funds
appropriated under subsections (4)(1) and (4)(n) of section 2 of
this act shall be the Mayor of the Lelu Municipal Government.
The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (4)(m)
and (4)(o) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the
Malem Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds
appropriated under subsection (4)(p) of section 2 of this act
shall be the Mayor of the Utwe Municipal Government. The
allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(q) of
section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Tafunsak
Municipal Government. The allottees shall be responsible for
ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified
in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of
the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to
obligate funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse."
