

A RESOLUTION

Requesting that the FSM Department of External Affairs request the Secretary of the United States Department of Agriculture to continue funding development projects in the Federated States of Micronesia through the Farmers Home Administration ("FMHA").

1 WHEREAS, the FMHA is the designated agency to administer
2 development projects in the Federated States of Micronesia during
3 the Compact of Free Association with the United States; and

4 WHEREAS, development projects administered and funded by the FMHA
5 in the past have contributed greatly to the health, well-being and
6 overall advancement of people in the Federated States of
7 Micronesia; and

8 WHEREAS, the continuation of community facility programs,
9 sewage, sanitation, and other water treatment programs, and related
10 buildings and infrastructure is essential for the well-being of the
11 people of the Federated States of Micronesia; and

12 WHEREAS, there is a particular need for a \$1.5 million water
13 treatment program in Kitti; and

14 WHEREAS, it is the understanding of Members of the Congress of
15 the Federated States of Micronesia that development projects,
16 including those for the Federated States of Micronesia, are now being
17 delayed in Washington, D.C. for possible assignment to another United
18 States agency; now, therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Eighth Congress of the Federated States
20 of Micronesia, First Special Session, 1994, that the Congress
21 respectfully requests the FSM Department of External Affairs to
22 request the Secretary of the United States Department of Agriculture
23 to continue funding development projects for the Federated States of
24 Micronesia through the Farmers Home Administration, and that in
25 particular the FMHA authorize the \$1.5 million water treatment


