15 WHEREAS, Jose C. Tenorio is thereby a great inspiration to all the
16 people of Micronesia for his hard work and diligent effort to upgrade
17 the economy and standard of living of his native Saipan; and


18 WHEREAS, Jose C. Tenorio's untimely passing is not only a great
