A RESOLUTION

Encouraging the sovereign nations of the world to recognize the government of the Republic of China.

1 WHEREAS, Article I of the Charter of the United Nations provides in
2 pertinent part that one of its purposes is "To develop friendly relations
3 among nations based on respect for the principle of equal rights and self-
4 determination of peoples, and to take other appropriate measures to
5 strengthen universal peace..."; and

6 WHEREAS, it is evident that the people who live on the island who
7 have designated their land as the "Republic of China" desire to be a
8 sovereign nation, free and independent of any other nation; and

9 WHEREAS, the people of the Federated States of Micronesia,
10 themselves citizens of island states, are in sympathy with the citizens of
11 the Republic of China who wish self-determination; now, therefore,

12 BE IT RESOLVED by the Eighth Congress of the Federated States of
13 Micronesia, Third Special Session, 1995, that the Congress hereby
14 encourages all sovereign nations to extend full and complete recognition to
15 the Republic of China; and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Branch of the
17 Federated States of Micronesia in its conduct of foreign affairs consult with
18 the Congress on the subject of this nation extending such recognition; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be
20 transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, and to
21 the government of the Republic of China.
