

## NINTH CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

SECOND REGULAR SESSION, 1995

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 9-109, C.D.1

## **ANACT**

To amend Public Law No. 9-30 to appropriate the sum of \$3,141,522 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, by amending section 5 to appropriate \$33,300 for the FSM Banking Board to be allocated as follows: \$16,800 to fund salaries and benefits for a Financial Analyst position, \$13,500 for an office automobile, and \$3,000 to purchase a portable computer; by amending section 11 to appropriate \$37,222 to Rural Economic and Community Development Services for a continued direct telecommunications link with the Rural Economic and Community Development Services finance office in St. Louis, and to appropriate \$71,000 to contribute to unpaid FSM Amateur Sports Association expenses; by amending section 13 to appropriate \$3,000,000 to increase funds available for new loans in the Business Development Loan Fund; by amending section 14 to increase the employment ceiling for the FSM Banking Board to 3 positions, and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 9-30 is hereby amended to read 1 2 as follows: "Section 5. Operating expenses of agencies of the National 3 Government. The sum of \$1,916,220, or so much thereof as may 4 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the 5 6 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, for the operations of independent agencies, 7 commissions, authorities, boards, bureaus, and other 8 organizations of the National Government of the Federated States 9 of Micronesia during fiscal year 1996.
