#### AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-10, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-42, 19-51, 19-56, 19-72, 19-78, 19-96, 19-132, 19-163, 20-03, 20-25 and 20-58, by amending sections 3 and 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social program in the states of Kosrae and Chuuk, and for other purposes.
