

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-49, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-68, 16-76, 17-06, 17-10, 17-23, 17-30, 17-32, 17-45, 17-82 and 17-85, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein to fund public projects and social programs in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 16-49, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 16-68, 16-76, 17-06, 17-23, 17-30 and 17-32
3 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the sum of \$2,215,000 appropriated by
5 this act, \$1,080,000 is apportioned for Chuuk State for
6 public projects and social programs.

7 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 16-49, as amended
 8 by Public Laws Nos. 17-10, 17-45 and 17-85, is hereby amended
 9 to read as follows:

10 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 11 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 12 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 13 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
 14 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 15 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 16 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
 17 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
 18 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
 19 appropriated. The allottee of funds appropriated under
 20 sections 2 and 4 of this act shall be the President of
 21 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
 22 PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
 23 section 4(1)(b) shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
 24 Authority and the allottee of the funds appropriated
 25 under section 4(1)(j) shall be the Mayor of Kolonia Town

1 Government. The allottee of funds appropriated under
2 section 3 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State.
3 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
4 5(1), 5(3) and 5(7) of this act shall be the Governor of
5 Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of funds
6 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be
7 the Mortlock Islands Development Authority (MIDA). [~~The~~
8 ~~allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of~~
9 ~~this act shall be the Executive Director of the Northern~~
10 ~~Namoneas Social and Economic Development Authority.~~] The
11 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of
12 this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
13 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
14 subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk
15 Development Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated
16 under subsection 5(6) of this act shall be the Northwest
17 Development Authority. The funds appropriated by this act
18 shall lapse on September 30, 2014.”

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25 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the

1 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
2 becoming law without such approval.
