

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 17-36, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-48, 17-78 and 17-87, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 17-36, as amended
2 by Public Law No. 17-48, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the sum of \$2,100,000 appropriated by
5 this act, \$900,000 is apportioned for Chuuk State for
6 public projects and social programs.

14 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 17-36, as amended
 15 by Public Laws Nos. 17-48, 17-78 and 17-87, is hereby further
 16 amended to read as follows:

17 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
 18 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
 19 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for
 20 in accordance with applicable laws, including, but
 21 not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
 22 The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that
 23 these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
 24 are used solely for the purpose specified in this
 25 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess

1 of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds
2 appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the
3 Governor of Yap State. The allottee of funds
4 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall
5 be the President of the Federated States of
6 Micronesia or his designee, EXCEPT THAT the allottee
7 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(b), 4(3)
8 (a) and (b) of section 4 of this act shall be the
9 Pohnpei Transportation Authority. The allottee of
10 funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(3) of
11 section 5 of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk
12 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
13 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of section 5 of
14 this act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development
15 Authority; ~~[the allottee of funds appropriated under~~
16 ~~subsection 5(3) of section 5 of this act shall be the~~
17 ~~Executive Director of the Northern Namoneas Social~~
18 ~~and Economic Development Authority,]~~ the allottee of
19 funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of section 5
20 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
21 Development Authority. The allottee of funds
22 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of section 5 of
23 this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.
24 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
25 5(6) of section 5 of this act shall be the Northwest

1 Islands Development Authority [~~(NWDA)~~] (NIDA),
2 PROVIDED THAT the allottee of the funds appropriated
3 under subsection 5(6)(f) shall be the President of
4 COM-FSM. The authority of the allottee to obligate
5 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
6 September 30, 2014."

7 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
8 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
9 becoming law without such approval.
