

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend [~~section 2~~] sections 2, 3 and 5 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by [~~Public Law No. 17-71~~] Public Law No. 17-71, 17-81, 17-84 and 17-89], for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the States of Yap and Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 17-71, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 2. Of the sum of \$5,697,383 appropriated by
5 this act, \$284,210 is apportioned to pay the amount owed
6 by the State of Yap to FEMA and \$600,000 is apportioned
7 for public projects and social programs in the State of
8 Yap.

9 (1) Amount owed by the State of Yap to FEMA PROVIDED
10 THAT this amount shall be deemed an advance. The
11 repayment of which shall be directed to the following
12 projects:

17 Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by
18 Public Law No. 17-71, is here by further amended as follows:
19 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse

1 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
2 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
3 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
4 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
5 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
6 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
7 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
8 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
9 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
10 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
11 State. The allottee of funds appropriated under
12 sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of
13 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee,
14 EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
15 subsection 1 of section 3 of this act shall be the
16 Governor of Kosrae State, the allottee of funds
17 appropriated under subsection 3(2)(p) of this act shall
18 be the Mayor of Lelu Municipal Government or his
19 designee and the allottee of funds appropriated under
20 subsection 1 of section 4 of this act shall be the
21 Governor of Pohnpei State. The allottee of funds
22 appropriated under subsection 5(1) of this act shall be
23 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
24 his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
25 subsection 5(2)(a) and 5(2)(c) of this act shall be the

1 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee
2 of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)(b) of
3 section 5 of this act shall be the Mortlock Islands
4 Development Authority. The allottee of funds
5 appropriated under subsection 5(2)(d) of section 5 of
6 this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
7 Authority or its designee. The allottee of funds
8 appropriated under subsection 5(2)(e) of section 5 of
9 this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority or
10 its designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
11 subsection 5(2)(f) of this act shall be the Northwest
12 Island Development Authority. The authority of the
13 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act
14 shall lapse on September 30, 2014."

15 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
16 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon it
17 becoming law without such approval.
