A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend section 404 of title 9 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, for the purpose of allowing the FSM Consulate Offices and Embassies to register new FSM eligible voters residing outside the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 404 of Title 9 of the Code of the
- 2 Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 "Section 404. Registration procedures.
- (1) A person desiring to register to vote in National
 Elections shall complete such applications and
 affidavits, take such oaths, and present such personal
 documentation and witnesses, as required by the rules
 and regulations promulgated by the National Election
- 10 Director pursuant to this title.
- 11 (2) A person desiring to register to vote in National
- 12 Elections and currently resides in a foreign country
- where the Federated States of Micronesia maintains an
- 14 embassy or consulate shall complete such applications
- and affidavits, take such oaths, and send such personal
- documentation and witnesses to that embassy or
- 17 <u>consulate, which shall then forward completed</u>
- 18 applications and affidavits of registration to the
- 19 national election commissioner of the relevant state for
- 20 final approval and entry onto the National Voter

1 Register, as required by the rules and regulations 2 promulgated by the National Election Director pursuant 3 to this title. $\left[\frac{(2)}{(3)}\right]$ Regardless of the place of registration, all 4 completed applications and affidavits of registration 5 shall be transmitted to the national election 6 commissioner of the relevant state for final approval 8 and entry onto the National Voter Register. $[\frac{(3)}{(4)}]$ Every completed application or affidavit of 9 10 registration shall be maintained and preserved at the National Election Office of the State of registration 11 12 until such time as the Registered Voter who completed the application or affidavit is deceased or is otherwise 13 14 no longer eligible to vote. $\left[\frac{4}{1}\right]$ (5) All completed applications and affidavits of 15 registration shall be open to public inspection during 16 regular business hours. 17 18 $[\frac{(5)}{(5)}]$ (6) The National Election Director may issue Voter Identification Cards to all Registered Voters at or 19 20 after the time of registration. All Voter 21 Identification Cards shall be issued free of charge, provided that, there shall be a charge in an amount to 22 23 be set out in the rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this title for issuing a Registered Voter 24 with a replacement Voter Identification Card. Upon 25

1	issuing a Voter Identification Card to a Registered
2	Voter, the National Election Director, or his or her
3	designee, shall make a notation next to that Registered
4	Voter's entry on the National Voter Register. A
5	Registered Voter who has been issued a Voter
6	Identification Card must present that card before being
7	issued a ballot at his or her Polling Place."
8	Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
9	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
10	becoming law without such approval.
