

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-05, as amended by Public Law No. 18-07, by amending sections 2, 3 and 5 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use of funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the States of Kosrae, Yap and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 18-05, as amended
