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A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 14-84, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 14-96, 14-103, 14-08, 15-13, 15-37, 15-42, 15-53, 16-8, 16-44, 17-17 and 17-61, by amending section 9 thereof, to change the allottee and lapse date of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

1           Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 14-84, as amended  
2 by Public Laws Nos. 14-96, 15-13, 15-53, 16-8, 16-44, 17-17 and  
3 17-61, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4           "Section 9. All funds appropriated by this act shall  
5 be allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for  
6 in accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
7 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

8           The allottee of the funds appropriated in Section 1  
9 of this Act shall be the President of the Federated  
10 States of Micronesia or the President's designee,  
11 PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated in  
12 subsection (1) (f) of Section 1 of this Act shall be  
13 the Governor of the State of Kosrae. The allottee of  
14 the funds appropriated in Sections 2 and 3 of this  
15 Act shall be the ~~[Chuuk State Commission on~~  
16 ~~Improvement Project]~~ Governor of Chuuk State or his  
17 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated in  
18 Section 4 of this Act shall be the Governor of Yap  
19 State. The allottee shall be responsible for

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1           ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may  
2           be necessary, are used solely for the purpose  
3           specified in this act, and that no obligations are  
4           incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The  
5           authority of the allottee to obligate funds  
6           appropriated by this Act shall lapse as of September  
7           30, [~~2013~~] 2014."

8           Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
9           President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
10          becoming law without such approval.
