## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 104 of title 11 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 11-72 and 11-76, and create a new subchapter III under chapter 6 to require the registration of deportees convicted of crimes in foreign countries, to provide penalties for failure to register, and in order to bring within definition of national crime the failure to register as a deportee, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Title 11 of the Code of the Federated States
- 2 of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by
- 3 creating a new subchapter III under chapter 6 entitled
- 4 "Registration of Deportees".
- 5 Section 2. Title 11 of the Code of the Federated States
- 6 of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by
- 7 inserting a new section 631 under subchapter III of chapter 6
- 8 to read as follows:
- "Section 631. Purpose of the subchapter. In view of 9 the increasing number of deportees who are being 10 returned to the Federated States of Micronesia for 11 criminal convictions for crimes against persons, 12 13 property, or against the public interest, and in view 14 of the number of deportees being returned before 15 their full sentence is completed in the United States or elsewhere, it is the purpose of this Act to 16 17 register all returning deportees for the safety of

1	the People of the Federated States of Micronesia."
2	Section 3. Title 11 of the Code of the Federated States
3	of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by
4	inserting a new section 631 under subchapter III of chapter 6
5	to read as follows:
6	"Section 632. Definition. As used in this section,
7	the term "convicted" means, with respect to a
8	person's felony or misdemeanor offense, a
9	determination or quilt, which is the result of a
10	trial or the entry of a plea of guilty or nolo
11	contendere, regardless of whether adjudication is
12	withheld."
13	Section 4. Title 11 of the Code of the Federated States
14	of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by
15	inserting a new section 633 under subchapter III of chapter 6
16	to read as follows:
17	"Section 633. Registration of deportees; exemptions;
18	penalties.
19	(1) Any person who has been convicted of a felony
20	or misdemeanor in any foreign territory,
21	commonwealth, or country shall, within 72 hours after
22	entering the Federated Stats of Micronesia, register
23	with the National Police, be fingerprinted and
24	photographed, and list the crime for which convicted,
25	place of conviction, sentence imposed, if any, name,

1	aliases, if any, address, and occupation.
2	(2) This section does not apply to an offender:
3	(a) Who has received a full pardon for the
4	offense for which convicted; or
5	(b) Who has been lawfully released from
6	incarceration or other sentence or supervision for a
7	felony or misdemeanor conviction, whichever is later
8	in time, for more than 5 years prior to such time for
9	registration, unless the offender is a fugitive from
10	justice on a felony charge or has been convicted of
11	any offense since release from such incarceration or
12	other sentence or supervision.
13	(3) Deportees who were deported to the Federated
14	States of Micronesia prior to the entry of this Act
15	shall have their information entered into the
16	National Police registration system by the National
17	Police together with a scanned copy of the deporting
18	documents.
19	(4) The failure of any such convicted person to
20	comply with this section with regard to any offender
21	not listed in subsection 3 of this section
22	constitutes a misdemeanor punishable under chapter 1
23	and chapter 12 of this title.
24	(5) A person convicted under this section shall be
25	imprisoned for not more than one year.

1	(6) Nothing in this section shall be construed to
2	affect any law of the Federated States of Micronesia
3	relating to registration of criminals where the
4	penalties for registration, notification, or
5	reporting obligations are in addition to, or in
6	excess of, those imposed by tis section."
7	Section 5. Section 104 title 11 of the Code of the
8	Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos.
9	11-72 and 11-76, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
10	(1) 'Crime' means an act committed or omitted in
11	violation of any law forbidding or commanding it, and
12	which, upon conviction, is punishable by either or
13	both of the following:
14	(a) imprisonment; or
15	(b) fine.
16	(2) 'Criminal negligence' means to engage in
17	conduct which creates a substantial and unjustifiable
18	risk of bodily injury to another, or to engage in
19	conduct which constitutes gross deviation from the
20	standard of care that a reasonable person would
21	exercise, which conduct causes the criminal result.
22	(3) 'Felony' means any crime, which is punishable
23	by imprisonment for more than one year.
24	(4) 'Intent' means acting with the conscious
2.5	purpose to engage in the conduct specified, refrain

1	from the omission specified or cause the specific
2	result.
3	(5) 'Knowledge' means being aware of the nature of
4	the conduct or omission or of the existing
5	circumstances, or believing that a fact exists which
6	brings the conduct or omission within the provisions
7	of this code. It does into require any knowledge of
8	the unlawfulness of such conduct or omission.
9	(6) 'Misdemeanor' means any crime, which is not a
10	felony.
11	(7) 'National crime' means:
12	(a) any crime, which is
13	(i) inherently national in character and
14	defined anywhere in this title; [or]
15	(ii) otherwise a crime against the
16	Federated States of Micronesia;
17	(b) A crime is 'inherently national in
18	character' when any of the following is true:
19	(i) the crime is committed in the
20	exclusive economic zone of the Federated States of
21	Micronesia as defined in title 18 of this Code;
22	(ii) the crime is committed in the airspace
23	above the territory comprising the Federated States
24	of Micronesia as defined in article I, section 1 of
25	the FSM Constitution;

1	(iii) the crime is committed on any airborne
2	vehicle of the National Government, regardless of
3	that vehicle's location;
4	(iv) the crime is committed on any
5	watergoing vessel flagged and registered by he
6	Federated States of Micronesia regardless of that
7	watergoing vessel's location;
8	(v) the crime is committed on any
9	watergong vessel of the National Government
10	regardless of that vessel's location;
11	(vi) the crime is committed against a
12	national public servant in the course of, in
13	connection with, or as a result of that person's
14	employment or services;
15	(vii) the crime is committed against a
16	former national public servant in retaliation for an
17	act undertaken while that person was engaged in
18	public service and within the scope of his or her
19	official duties;
20	(viii) the crime is committed by a national
21	public official or public servant while that person
22	is engaged in his or her official duties or in
23	violation of a fiduciary duty;
24	(ix) the crime involves property belonging
25	to the National Government; [ <del>or</del> ]

1	(x) the crime is committed against any
2	person participating in or attempting to participate
3	in a national election; or
4	(xi) a person has been convicted of a
5	felony or misdemeanor in any foreign territory,
6	commonwealth, or country and fails to register as a
7	deportee whenever required by a law of the Federated
8	States of Micronesia to register.
9	(8) 'Official proceeding' means any procedure
10	conducted by or under the supervision of a judge,
11	magistrate, judicial officer or other public official
12	in relation to any alleged offense or proven offense
13	and includes an inquiry, investigation, or
14	preliminary or final determination of facts.
15	(9) Person. The terms 'person', 'he', 'she',
16	'accused' and 'defendant' include any natural or
17	legal person, including but not limited to, a
18	government, corporation or unincorporated
19	association, or other organization.
20	(10) 'Principal' means a person who commits or
21	participates in the commission of a crime and shall
22	include a co-conspirator, accomplice or an aid or
23	abettor.
24	(11) 'Public official' and 'public servant' means
25	any person elected, appointed or employee to perform

a governmental function on behalf of the Federated Stats of Micronesia, or any department, agency or branch thereof, or any allottee as defined in the Financial Management Act of 1979, in any official function under or by authority of any such agency or branch of government. The terms include, but are not limited to, legislators, judges, law enforcement officers, advisors and consultants, but do not include witnesses.

- (12) 'Reckless' means to engage in conduct with a willful disregard for the safety of others or to engage in conduct in a manner that constitutes a gross deviation from the standard of care that a reasonable person would exercise in the situation.
- (13) 'Serious bodily injury' means bodily injury which creates a high probability of death or which causes serious permanent disfigurement or which causes a permanent or protracted loss or impairment of the function of any bodily member or organ, or other bodily injury of like severity.
- (14) 'Willfully' means to act with a purpose or willingness to commit an act, or to make an omission. It does not require any intent to violate the law, or to injure another, or to acquire any advantage.
  - (15) 'Property' shall mean both real and personal

1	property."
2	Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
3	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
4	becoming law without such approval.
