

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-187, 22-188, 23-03, 23-09, 23-11, 23-36 and 23-59 by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

2 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by  
3 Public Laws Nos. 22-187, 22-188, 23-03, 23-09, 23-11 and 23-36,  
4 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

5 "Section 5. Of the \$8,820,000 appropriated under this  
6 act, \$3,780,000 shall be apportioned for public projects  
7 and social programs for the people of Chuuk State.

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1           Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 22-188, 23-11 and 23-36, is hereby further  
3 amended to read as follows:

4           "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
5 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
6 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
7 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
8 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
9 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
10 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
11 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
12 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
13 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
14 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap  
15 State or his designee. The allottee of funds  
16 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be  
17 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or  
18 his designee; EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds  
19 appropriated under section 3(1) of this act shall be the  
20 Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee  
21 of funds appropriated under section 3(2) of this act  
22 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his  
23 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
24 subsections 4(1)(b), 4(1)(k), 4(1)(l), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b),  
25 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(n),

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1 4(2) (p), 4(2) (s), 4(2) (t), 4(2) (u), 4(2) (v), 4(3) (q) and  
2 4(2) (aa) and 4(2) (ab) of this act shall be the Secretary  
3 of the Department of Transportation, Communications and  
4 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds  
5 appropriated under subsections 4(1) (a), 4(1) (j),  
6 4(2) (f), 4(2) (j), 4(2) (k), 4(2) (l), 4(2) (m), 4(2) (r),  
7 4(2) (x), 4(3) (m) and 4(2) (n) of this act shall be the  
8 Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of  
9 funds appropriated under subsection 4(2) (i) of this act  
10 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Education or  
11 her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
12 subsection 4(2) (o) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Port  
13 Authority (PPA); the allottee of funds appropriated  
14 under subsections 4(2) (w), 4(2) (q) and 4(2) (z) of this  
15 act shall be the Mayor of Sapwuahfik Municipal  
16 Government or his designee, the allottee of funds  
17 appropriated under subsections 4(2) (ac) and 4(2) (ad) of  
18 this act shall be the Sokehs Municipal Government; the  
19 allottee of funds appropriated under section 5(1) of  
20 this act shall be the At-large office; the allottee of  
21 the funds appropriated under section [~~subsections 5(1)~~  
22 ~~and~~] 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk  
23 State or his designee; the allottee of the funds  
24 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be  
25 the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the

1 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(3)  
2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal  
3 Government or his designee; the allottee of the funds  
4 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be  
5 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the  
6 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5)  
7 of this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.  
8 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds  
9 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,  
10 2025.”

11 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
12 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
13 becoming law without such approval.
