

AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 8, and 9 of Public Law No. 20-131, to appropriate \$3,358,000 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, to provide funding for the operations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-131 is hereby  
2 amended to read as follows:

3                   "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to  
4                   appropriate the sum of [~~\$64,819,927~~] \$68,177,927 from  
5                   the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia  
6                   for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, for the  
7                   purpose of funding the operations of all branches of  
8                   the National Government of the Federated States of  
9                   Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants,  
10                  subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human  
11                  Resources Development. The National Government's share  
12                  of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero;  
13                  EXCEPT THAT; the National Government will retain the  
14                  Compact Sector Grant amount for COM-FSM and 10 percent  
15                  of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is  
16                  reflected in the budget for the Department of  
17                  Education. The sum appropriated herein shall be

1           apportioned as follows:"
