
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-71, 17-81, 17-84, 17-89, 17-90, 18-03, 18-10, 18-13, 18-32, 18-46, 18-58, 18-87, 18-95, 19-16, 19-47, 19-87, 19-98, 19-123, 20-28, 20-107, 21-32 and 21-164, by amending sections 4 and 6 therein, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated thereof, to fund public projects and social programs for Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 17-71, 17-84, 18-32, 18-46, 18-58, 18-95, 19-47,
3 19-98 and 19-123, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4. Of the sum of \$5,697,383 appropriated by
5 this act, \$219,116 is apportioned to pay the amount owed
6 by the state of Pohnpei to FEMA and \$1,200,000 is
7 apportioned for public projects and social programs in
8 the state of Pohnpei.

3 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by
4 Public Laws Nos. 17-71, 18-03, 18-13, 18-58, 18-87, 19-16, 19-98,
5 20-28, 20-107, 21-32 and 21-164, is here by further amended to
6 read as follows:

7 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
8 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
9 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
10 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
11 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
12 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
13 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
14 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
15 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
16 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
17 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
18 State. The allottee of funds appropriated under sections
19 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of the
20 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, EXCEPT
21 THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
22 1 of section 3 of this act shall be the Governor of
23 Kosrae; the allottee of funds appropriated under
24 subsections 3(2)(j), (k), (l), (m), (n), (o), (p), (q),
25 (r), (s), (t), (u), (v), (w), (x), (y), (z), (aa), (ab),

1 (ac), (ad), (ae), (af), (ag) and (ah) of section 3 of
2 this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Municipal Government
3 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
4 subsection 1 of section 4 of this act shall be the
5 Governor of Pohnpei State and the allottee of funds
6 appropriated under subsections 4(c)(xxiii) and 4(c)(xxiv)
7 of section 4 of this act shall be the Meninkeder lapalap,
8 Madolenihmw Municipal Government. The allottee of funds
9 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(b)(x) of this act
10 shall be the Secretary of the Department of
11 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his
12 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
13 subsection 5(1) of this act shall be the President of the
14 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee. The
15 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)(a)
16 and 5(2)(f) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk
17 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
18 appropriated under subsection 5(2)(b) of section 5 of
19 this act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development
20 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
21 subsection 5(2)(c) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno
22 Municipal Government or his designee. The allottee of
23 funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)(d) of section 5
24 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
25 Authority or its designee. The allottee of funds
