

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-141, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-145, 20-163, 20-164, 20-190, 21-05, 21-33, 21-48, 21-67, 21-91, 21-182, 21-193, 22-34 and 22-69, by amending section 3 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other projects and programs in the state of Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 20-141, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 20-145, 20-163, 20-164, 21-33, 21-48, 21-67 and
3 22-69, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 3. Of the \$12,800,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$2,000,000 shall be apportioned for priority
6 infrastructure projects and other projects and programs
7 in the state of Kosrae.

14 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-141, as amended
 15 by Public Laws Nos. 20-163, 20-164, 20-190, 21-05, 21-33, 21-48,
 16 21-91, 21-193 and 22-34, is hereby further amended to read as
 17 follows:

18 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
 19 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
 20 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 21 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 22 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 23 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 24 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
 25 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that

1 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
2 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
3 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of
4 Yap State or his designee PROVIDED THAT the allottee of
5 funds appropriated under subsections 2(a) and 2(b) of
6 this act shall be the President of the Federated States
7 of Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of the
8 funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act
9 shall be the President of the Federated States of
10 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee
11 of funds appropriated under subsections 3(a), 3(b),
12 3(c), 3(e), 3(f), 3(g), 3(h), 3(j), 3(k), 3(l), 3(m),
13 3(n), 3(o), 3(p), 3(q), 3(s), 3(t), 3(u), 3(v), 3(w),
14 3(x), 3(y), 3(z), 3(a3) to 3(a10), 3(a30) and 3(a31) of
15 this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or
16 his designee; EXCEPT that, the allottee of funds
17 appropriated under subsection 3(a16) of this act shall
18 be the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal Government or his
19 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
20 subsections 3(d), 3(i), 3(r), 3(a2) and 3(a11) to
21 3(a25) of this act shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak
22 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee the
23 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections (a27),
24 (a28) and (a29) of this act shall be the Governor of
25 Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee of funds

1 appropriated under subsection 3(a26) is the Secretary
2 of the FSM Department of Education or his designee; the
3 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1) of
4 this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
5 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or
6 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
7 subsections 4(2)(a) to 4(2)(s), 4(2)(ab), 4(3)(a),
8 4(3)(b), 4(3)(c), 4(3)(d), 4(3)(k), 4(3)(x), 4(4)(a),
9 4(4)(b), 4(4)(c), 4(4)(d), 4(4)(g), 4(4)(h), 4(4)(i),
10 4(4)(j) and 4(4)(k) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
11 Transportation Authority (PTA) except that the allottee
12 of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(l) of this
13 act shall be the Administrator of MiCare program or her
14 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
15 subsection 4(3)(n) of this act shall be the Secretary
16 of the Department of Health and Social Affairs or her
17 designee, the allottee of funds appropriated under
18 subsections 4(2)(h), 4(2)(q), 4(2)(u), 4(2)(ac),
19 4(2)(v), 4(2)(w), 4(2)(x), and 4(2)(z) of this act
20 shall be the Secretary of the Department of
21 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or
22 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
23 subsection 4(2)(y) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
24 Port Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated
25 under subsection 4(2)(aa) of this act shall be the

1 Chief Magistrate of Sokehs Municipal Government or his
2 designee; the allottee of fund appropriated under
3 subsection and 4(4)(l) of this act shall be the Mayor
4 of Pingelap Municipal Government; the allottee of funds
5 appropriated under subsection and 4(4)(m) of this act
6 shall be the Chief Magistrate of Mwoakilloa Municipal
7 Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under
8 subsections 4(3)(e), 4(3)(f), 4(3)(j), 4(3)(p), 4(3)(w)
9 and 4(3)(z) of this act shall be the Menin Keder
10 Lapalap of Madolenihmw; the allottee of funds
11 appropriated 4(3)(a5) shall be the Secretary of the
12 Department of Health and Social Affairs. The allottee
13 of the funds appropriated sections 5 of this act shall
14 be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee;
15 PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under
16 subsections 5(g) and 5(j) of this act shall be the FSM
17 Telecommunication Corporation or its designee and the
18 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 5(d)
19 and 5(e) of this act shall be the FSM Secretary of the
20 Department of Transportation, Communications and
21 Infrastructure or his designee. The authority of the
22 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act
23 shall lapse on September 30, 2023.”
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1 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
