

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 22-86, by amending sections 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allotte of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other public projects and social programs for the people of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 22-86 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

5 Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-86 is hereby amended
 6 to read as follows:

7 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 8 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 9 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 10 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not limited
 11 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee
 12 shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so
 13 much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the
 14 purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are
 15 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee
 16 of the funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall
 17 be the Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee
 18 of funds appropriated under subsection 3(1) of this act
 19 shall be the Governor of the State of Kosrae or his
 20 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
 21 subsection 3(2) of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town
 22 Government or his designee. The allottee of funds
 23 appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the
 24 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
 25 designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated

1 under subsection 4(1)(c) of this act shall be the FSM
2 Telecommunication Corporation; the allottee of funds
3 appropriated under subsection 4(1)(g) of this act shall be
4 the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC); the allottee of
5 funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(a), 4(2)(a),
6 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(f), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i),
7 4(2)(j) and 4(2)(l) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
8 Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds
9 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(j), 4(2)(d) and 4(3)(l)
10 of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
11 Resources and Development or her designee; the allottee of
12 the funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(b), 4(1)(d),
13 4(1)(e), 4(1)(f), 4(1)(h), 4(1)(k), 4(1)(l), 4(1)(m),
14 4(1)(n), 4(2)(g), 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b), 4(3)(c), 4(3)(d),
15 4(3)(e), 4(3)(f), 4(3)(g), 4(3)(h), 4(3)(j) and 4(3)(k) of
16 this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
17 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his
18 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
19 subsection 4(2)(k) of this act shall be the President of
20 the COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds
21 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(i) [~~and~~] 4(3)(o) and
22 4(3)(i) of this act shall be the Secretary of the
23 Department of Health and Social Affairs or her designee;
24 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(m)
25 of this act shall be the Vice President of the Federated

1 States of Micronesia or his designee; the allottee of funds
2 appropriated under subsection 4(3)(n) of this act shall be
3 the Meninkeder Lapoloap of Madolenihmw. The allottee of
4 the funds appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(2) and
5 5(7) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or
6 his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
7 subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island
8 Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of funds
9 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the
10 Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee; the
11 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of
12 this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
13 Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
14 subsection 5(6) of this act shall be the Faichuk
15 Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to
16 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
17 September 30, 2024.

18 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
19 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
20 becoming law without such approval.
