
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend sections 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 21-185, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-210, 21-221, 21-238, 22-01, 22-30, and 22-41, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to change the allottee of certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 21-185, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 21-210, 21-221 21-238, 22-01, 22-30, and 22-41 is
3 hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.

5 The sum of \$16,473,088 or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
7 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
8 year ending September 30, 2021, for the following
9 capital improvements, development programs, and projects
10 and human resources development. Of the total amount of
11 funds appropriated herein, \$1,246,022 shall be deemed to
12 come from funds available under the Supplemental
13 Education Grant and \$1,000,000 shall be deemed to come
14 from funds available under the Compact Sector Grants.
15 The sum appropriated by this section shall be
16 apportioned as follows:

15 Section 2. Section 12 of Public Law No. 21-185, as amended
 16 by Public Laws Nos. 21-210, 21-221, 21-238, 22-01, and 22-41 is
 17 hereby further amended to read as follows:

18 "Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and
 19 Lapse Dates.

20 (1) General provisions.

21 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 22 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 23 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
 24 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

25 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for

1 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
2 necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in
3 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
4 of the sums appropriated.

5 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
6 appropriated by this act are as follows:

7 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds
8 shall be the President of the Federated States of
9 Micronesia;

10 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds
11 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
12 States of Micronesia;

13 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds
14 shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
15 Federated States of Micronesia;

16 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds
17 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
18 Micronesia;

19 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these
20 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
21 Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following
22 subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:

23 (i) Sections 8(1)(f) and 8(13)(q) - the
24 allottee of these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint
25 Committee on Compact Review and Planning;

1 (ii) Section 8(8)(a) – the allottee of these
2 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;

3 (iii) Section 8(8)(b) – the allottee of these
4 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;

5 (iv) Section 8(8)(c) – the allottee of these
6 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

7 (v) Section 8(8)(d) – the allottee of these
8 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;

9 (vi) Section 8(11) – the allottee of these
10 funds shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated
11 States of Micronesia;

12 (vii) Sections 8(12) and 9(11)(v) – the
13 allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker of the
14 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia;

15 (viii) Section 8(13)(a) – the allottee of
16 these funds shall be the President of the College of
17 Micronesia-FSM;

18 (ix) Section 8(13)(d) through (g) – the
19 allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of
20 the respective State Supreme Court;

21 (x) Section 8(13)(h) – the allottee of
22 these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme
23 Court of the Federated States of Micronesia;

24 (xi) Section 8(13)(t) – the allottee of
25 these funds shall be the National Olympic Committee;

1 (xii) Section 8(13)(u) - the allottee of
2 these funds shall be the Principal of Saint Cecilia
3 Catholic School;

4 (xiii) Section 9(1) - the allottee of these
5 funds shall be the President of the College of
6 Micronesia-FSM;

7 (xiv) Section 9(3)(b) - the allottee of these
8 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;

9 (xv) Section 9(3)(c) - the allottee of these
10 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;

11 (xvi) Sections 9(3)(d) and 9(11)(w) - the
12 allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of the
13 state of Chuuk;

14 (xvii) Section 9(3)(e) - the allottee of these
15 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;

16 (xviii) Section 9(4)(i) - the allottee of these
17 funds shall be the Secretary of the Department of
18 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure;

19 (xix) Sections 9(11)(b), 9(11)(n) and
20 9(11)(v) - the allottee of these funds shall be the
21 Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of
22 Micronesia;

23 (xx) Section 9(11)(d) - the allottee of
24 these funds shall be the President of the Constitutional
25 Convention;

1 (xxi) Section 9(11)(f) – the allottee of
2 these funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

3 (xxii) Section 9(11)(g) – the allottee of
4 these funds shall be the Secretary of the Department of
5 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure;

6 (xxiii) Section 8(13)(r) the allottee of these
7 funds shall be the Governor of the State of Yap;

8 (xxiv) Section 9(3)(y) – the allottee of these
9 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

10 (xxv) Section 9(3)(z) – the allottee of these
11 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;

12 (xxvi) Section 9(3)(aa) – the allottee of
13 these funds shall be the Governor of the state of
14 Kosrae;

15 (xxvii) Section 9(3)(bb) – the allottee of
16 these funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;

17 (xxviii) Section 9(11)(p) and (s) – the allottee
18 of these funds shall be the Governor of the State of
19 Chuuk;

20 (xxix) Section 9(11)(q) – the allottee of these
21 funds shall be the Governor of the State of Yap;

22 (xxx) Section 9(11)(r) – the allottee of these
23 funds shall be the Governor of the State of Kosrae;

24 (xxxi) Section 9(3)(t) – the allottee of these
25 funds shall be the President of the FSM Association of

1 Chamber of Commerce; and

2 (xxxii) Section 9(4)(h) – the allottee of these
3 funds shall be the Governor of the State of Chuuk

4 (xxxiii) Section 9(4)(j) – the allottee of
5 these funds shall be the Governor of the State of Yap.”

6 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
7 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
8 becoming law without such approval.
