

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-54, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-62, 19-75, 19-79, 19-99, 19-119, 20-04, 20-56, 20-82, 20-127, 21-20, 21-117, 21-169, 21-174, 21-194, 21-205 and 21-233, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs in the state of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 19-54, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 19-62, 19-79, 19-99, 19-119, 19-129 and 19-173,  
3 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

20 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-54, as amended by  
 21 Public Laws Nos. 19-62, 19-75, 19-99, 19-129, 20-04, 20-127, 21-20  
 22 and 21-117, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

23 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
 24 date. All fund appropriated by this act shall be  
 25 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in

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1           accordance with applicable laws including, but not  
2           limited to, the applicable laws, including, but not  
3           limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
4           allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
5           funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
6           solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
7           no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
8           appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
9           under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap  
10          State. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
11          sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of  
12          the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;  
13          PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under  
14          subsections 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h),  
15          (t), (u), (v), (ag), (ar) and (as) of this act shall be  
16          the Mayor of Utwe Municipal Government or his designee;  
17          the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
18          3(k), (w), (x), (y), (z), (aa), (ab), (ac), (ad), (ae),  
19          (af), (ah), (ai), (aj), (ak), (al), (am), (an), (ao),  
20          (ap) and (aq) of this act shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak  
21          Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of  
22          funds appropriate under subsections [†] 4(1)(a), (b),  
23          (c), (e), (f), and 4(2) shall be the Secretary of the  
24          Department of Transportation, Communications and  
25          Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
