## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend section 9 of Public Law No. 21-185, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-210, 21-221 and 21-238, to deappropriate the FY21 funding for Slipping of Patrol Boat, and utilize the deappropriated funding for the expenses for the court cases in Yap handled by DOJ, procurement of police equipment and supplies, POL for patrol boats and vehicles, COVID Emergency Travel of law enforcement officers to the States, and for the Surveillance Revolving Fund, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 21-185, as amended by
- 2 Public Laws Nos. 21-210, 21-221 and 21-238, is hereby further
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.
- 5 The sum of \$14,790,063 or so much thereof as may be
- 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
- 7 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
- 8 ending September 30, 2021, for the following capital
- 9 improvements, development programs, and projects and
- 10 human resources development. Of the total amount of
- funds appropriated herein, \$1,246,022 shall be deemed to
- 12 come from funds available under the Supplemental
- 13 Education Grant and \$1,000,000 shall be deemed to come
- 14 from funds available under the Compact Sector Grants.
- The sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned
- 16 as follows:
