

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by Public Law No. 22-187, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 22-180 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 4. Of the \$8,820,000 appropriated under this act,
4 \$2,520,000 shall be apportioned for public projects and social
5 programs for the people of Pohnpei State.

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1 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-180 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
4 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
5 managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with
6 applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the
7 Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be
8 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much
9 thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose
10 specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred
11 in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the
12 funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the
13 Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds
14 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the
15 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
16 designee; EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated
17 under section 3(1) of this act shall be the Governor of
18 Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee of funds
19 appropriated under section 3(2) of this act shall be the
20 Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the allottee
21 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b),
22 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(n),
23 4(2)(p), 4(2)(s), 4(2)(t), 4(2)(u) and 4(2)(v) of this act
24 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
25 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the

1 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(f),
2 4(2)(j), 4(2)(k), 4(2)(l), 4(2)(m), [~~4(2)(g)~~] and 4(2)(r) of
3 this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority
4 (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
5 4(2)(i) of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department
6 of Education or her designee; the allottee of funds
7 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(o) of this act shall be
8 the Pohnpei Port Authority (PPA); the allottee of funds
9 appropriated under subsections 4(2)(w) and 4(2)(q) of this
10 act shall be the Mayor of Sapwuahfik Municipal Government or
11 his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
12 subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor
13 of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of the funds
14 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the
15 Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee
16 of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act
17 shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his
18 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
19 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
20 Development Authority; the allottee of the funds
21 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the
22 Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the
23 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall
24 lapse on September 30, 2025.

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1 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
