

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 21-201, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-219, 21-223, 21-229, 21-241, 22-28 and 22-31, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund priority infrastructure projects and other public projects and social programs for the people of Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 21-201, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 21-219, 21-223, 21-229, 21-241 and 22-28, is  
3 hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the \$8,400,000 appropriated under this  
5 act, \$3,600,000 shall be apportioned for priority  
6 infrastructure projects and other public projects and  
7 social programs for the people of Chuuk State.

17 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 21-201, as amended by  
 18 Public Law No. 21-219, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

19 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
 20 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
 21 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
 22 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
 23 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
 24 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
 25 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used

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1 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no  
2 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
3 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
4 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap  
5 State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated  
6 under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President  
7 of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;  
8 PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under  
9 subsection 3(1) of this act shall be the Governor of  
10 Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee of funds  
11 appropriated under subsection 3(2) of this act shall be  
12 the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the  
13 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1) and  
14 4(2) of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department  
15 of Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or  
16 his designee; EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds  
17 appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c),  
18 4(2)(e), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i), 4(2)(j), and 4(2)(k) of this  
19 act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the  
20 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(d) of  
21 this act shall be the President of the COM-FSM, the  
22 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(g) of  
23 this act shall be the FSM Telecommunications Corporation.  
24 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
25 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b), 4(3)(d), 4(3)(f), 4(3)(i), 4(3)(m) and

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1           4(3)(t) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation  
2           Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
3           subsections 4(3)(c), 4(3)(e), 4(3)(g), 4(3)(h), 4(3)(j),  
4           4(3)(k), 4(3)(l), and 4(3)(o) of this act shall be the  
5           Meninkeder of Madolenihmw; the allottee of funds  
6           appropriated under subsections 4(3)(n) and 4(3)(q) of this  
7           act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health and  
8           Social Affairs or his designee; the allottee of funds  
9           appropriated under subsections 4(3)(p), 4(3)(r) and  
10          4(3)(s) of this act shall be the Vice President of the  
11          Federated States of Micronesia; The allottee of the funds  
12          appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(2)(j) and 5(6) of  
13          this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his  
14          designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
15          subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island  
16          Development Authority (MIDA); [~~EXCEPT subsection 5(2)(j),~~]  
17          the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(3)  
18          of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal  
19          Government or his designee the allottee of the funds  
20          appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be  
21          the Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee  
22          of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this  
23          act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The  
24          authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated  
25          by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2023."

1           Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.
