

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-60, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-65, 20-75, 20-85, 20-97, 20-150, 21-69, 21-84, 21-100, 21-129, 21-163, 21-173, 21-187, 22-11, 22-59, 22-78 and 22-132, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use, allottee and extend the lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs in Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 20-60, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 20-65, 20-85, 20-150, 21-60, 21-84, 22-11, 22-59
3 and 22-123, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the \$4,450,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$1,800,000 shall be apportioned for public projects
6 and social programs in the state of Chuuk.

17 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-60, as
 18 amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-65, 20-75, 20-97, 21-129,
 19 21-163, 21-173, 22-78 and 22-132, is hereby further amended
 20 to read as follows:

21 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 22 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 23 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 24 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 25 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The

1 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
2 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
3 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
4 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
5 appropriated. The allottee of funds appropriated under
6 section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State
7 or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
8 appropriated under subsections 2(i), 2(j) and 2(n) of
9 this act shall be the President or his designee. The
10 allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 3 and
11 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated
12 States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the
13 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(a) to
14 3(o) and subsection 3(af) of this act shall be the Mayor
15 of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the allottee of
16 funds appropriated under subsections 3(p) to 3(ae) of
17 this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his
18 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
19 subsections 4(1)(m) and 4(1)(o) of this act shall be the
20 Mayor of Pingelap or his designee; the allottee of funds
21 appropriated under subsections 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g) and
22 4(2)(m) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
23 Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated
24 under subsection 4(2)(o) of this act shall be the
25 Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC). The allottee of funds

1 appropriated under section 5(1) of this act shall be the
2 At-large office. The allottee of the funds appropriated
3 under [~~subsections 5(1) and~~] section 5(6) of this act
4 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee;
5 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
6 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island
7 Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of funds
8 appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act shall be
9 the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee;
10 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
11 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
12 Development Authority; the allottee of the funds
13 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be
14 the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the
15 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act
16 shall lapse on September 30, [~~2024~~] 2026."

17 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
18 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
19 becoming law without such approval.
