

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-187, 22-188, 23-03 and 23-09, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 22-180, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 22-187, 22-188, 23-03 and 23-09, is hereby
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the \$8,820,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$3,780,000 shall be apportioned for public projects
6 and social programs for the people of Chuuk State.

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1 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 22-188, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 “Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
5 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
6 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
7 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not limited
8 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee
9 shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so
10 much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the
11 purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are
12 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee
13 of the funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall
14 be the Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee
15 of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act
16 shall be the President of the Federated States of
17 Micronesia or his designee; EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of
18 funds appropriated under section 3(1) of this act shall be
19 the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee
20 of funds appropriated under section 3(2) of this act shall
21 be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the
22 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(b),
23 4(1)(k), 4(1)(l), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d),
24 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(n), 4(2)(p), 4(2)(s),
25 4(2)(t), 4(2)(u) and 4(2)(v) of this act shall be the

1 Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
2 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the
3 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(a),
4 4(1)(j), 4(2)(f), 4(2)(j), 4(2)(k), 4(2)(l), 4(2)(m),
5 4(2)(r), 4(2)(x), 4(3)(m) and 4(2)(n) of this act shall be
6 the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of
7 funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(i) of this act
8 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Education or
9 her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
10 subsection 4(2)(o) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Port
11 Authority (PPA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
12 subsections 4(2)(w), 4(2)(q), [~~4(2)(y)~~] and 4(2)(z) of this
13 act shall be the Mayor of Sapwuahfik Municipal Government
14 or his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated
15 under subsection 4(2)(y) of this act shall be the Mayor of
16 Sokehs Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee
17 of the funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6)
18 of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
19 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
20 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island
21 Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the funds
22 appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the
23 Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee; the
24 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of
25 this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development

1 Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
2 subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk
3 Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to
4 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
5 September 30, 2025.

6 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
7 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
8 becoming law without such approval.
