A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 9 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-64, 20-67, 20-83, 20-94, 20-103, 20-122 and 20-148, to change the use of certain CIP line item in the FY18 Budget Act in order to provide for other Capital and Human Resources Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by
- 2 Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-64, 20-67, 20-83, 20-94, 20-103,
- 3 20-122 and 22-148 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

- 5 The sum of \$119,685,179, or so much thereof as may be
- 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
- 7 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
- year ending September 30, 2018, for the following

- 10 and human resources development. Of the total amount of
- funds appropriated herein, \$1,246,022 shall be deemed to
- 12 come from funds available under the Amended Compact from
- the Supplemental Education Grant and \$5,252,250 shall be
- 14 deemed to come from funds available under the Amended
- 15 Compact from Compact Sector Grants. The sum
- appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as
