

A RESOLUTION

Approving and accepting an agreement on foreign financial assistance from the Government of the United States of America in the amount of \$88,900 including all the terms and conditions of the assistance.

1           WHEREAS, the Government of the United States through the  
2 Department of Interior extended, and FSM accepted, a financial  
3 grant (the "Grant") in the amount of \$88,900 as evidenced by a  
4 grant award, executed by the Department of Interior on August  
5 19, 2010 and accepted on behalf of the Federated States of  
6 Micronesia on August 23, 2010; and

7           WHEREAS, the Grant Award indicates its exclusive purpose  
8 which is to assist the Department of Justice, Division of  
9 Immigration and Labor to install two Passport Issuance Stations  
10 at the Overseas Consulate Offices in Hawaii and Guam; and

11           WHEREAS, pursuant to section 210(1)(b) of title 55 of the  
12 FSM Code, the Grant constitutes "foreign financial assistance",  
13 and the acceptance thereof constitutes the "agreement" as the  
14 term is understood under section 210(1)(a) of title 55 of the  
15 FSM Code; and

16           WHEREAS, Pursuant to section 210(2) of title 55 of the  
17 FSM Code, no agreement shall be valid, and no funds may be  
18 received pursuant to such agreement, unless and until Congress  
19 approves the agreement by resolution; now, therefore;

20           BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventeenth Congress of the

1 Federated States of Micronesia, First Regular Session, 2011,  
2 that the \$88,900 Grant from the Government of the United States  
3 is hereby approved and accepted; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Congress is grateful and  
5 appreciative to the Government of the United States for its  
6 assistance; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
8 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated  
9 States of Micronesia, the Secretary of the Department of  
10 Foreign Affairs, the Secretary of the Department of Justice and  
11 the Embassy of the United States.
