

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-71, 17-81, 17-84, 17-89, 17-90, 18-03 and 18-10, by amending sections 3, 5 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the States of Kosrae and Chuuk; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 17-71, 17-84 and 18-03, is hereby further
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 3. Of the sum of \$5,697,383 appropriated
5 by this act, \$15,197 is apportioned to pay the
6 amount owed by the State of Kosrae to FEMA and
7 \$600,000 is apportioned for public projects and
8 social programs in the State of Kosrae.

 6 apportioned for public projects and social programs.

22 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by
 23 Public Laws Nos. 17-71 and 18-03, is here by further amended to
 24 read as follows:

25 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse

1 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
2 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
3 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
4 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
5 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
6 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
7 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
8 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
9 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
10 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
11 State. The allottee of funds appropriated under
12 sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of
13 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee,
14 EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
15 subsection 1 of section 3 of this act shall be the
16 Governor of Kosrae; the allottee of funds appropriated
17 under subsections 3(2)(j), (k), (l), (m), (n), (o), (p),
18 (q), (r), (s), (t), (u), (v), (w), (x), (y), (z), (aa),
19 (ab), (ac), (ad), (ae), (af), (ag) and (ah) of section 3
20 of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Municipal
21 Government or his designee and the allottee of funds
22 appropriated under subsection 1 of section 4 of this act
23 shall be the Governor of Pohnpei State. The allottee of
24 funds appropriated under subsection 5(1) of this act
25 shall be the President of the Federated States of

1 Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of funds
2 appropriated under subsection 5(2)(a) and 5(2)(c) of
3 this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
4 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
5 subsection 5(2)(b) of section 5 of this act shall be the
6 Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The allottee of
7 funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)(d) of section 5
8 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
9 Authority or its designee. The allottee of funds
10 appropriated under subsection 5(2)(e) of section 5 of
11 this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority or
12 its designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
13 subsection 5(2)(f) of section 5 of this act shall be the
14 Northwest Island Development Authority. The authority
15 of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this
16 act shall lapse on September 30, 2014."

17 Section 4. Purpose of Amendments:

18 1. The purpose of the amendments are merely shifting available
19 funding within each line item under Kosrae State, and to change
20 the allottee of certain funds for Kosrae State. And, also
21 changing the use of funds under election District No. 5, Chuuk
22 State. There is no increase or decrease of funding.

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25 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the

1 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon it
2 becoming law without such approval.
