

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-187, 22-188, 23-03, 23-09, 23-11, 23-36 and 23-59, by amending sections 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

22 Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-180, as
 23 amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-188, 23-11 and 23-36, is hereby
 24 further amended to read as follows:

1 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
2 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
3 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
4 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
5 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
6 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
7 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
8 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
9 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
10 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
11 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
12 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
13 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be
14 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
15 his designee; EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds
16 appropriated under section 3(1) of this act shall be the
17 Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee
18 of funds appropriated under section 3(2) of this act
19 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
20 designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
21 appropriated under subsection 3(2) (x) of this act shall
22 be the Mayor of Utwe Municipal Government or his
23 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
24 subsection 3(2) (y) of this act shall be the Mayor of
25 Malem or his designee; the allottee of funds

1 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(b), 4(1)(k),
2 4(1)(l), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e),
3 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(n), 4(2)(p), 4(2)(s), 4(2)(t),
4 4(2)(u), 4(2)(v), 4(3)(q) and 4(2)(aa) and 4(2)(ab) of
5 this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
6 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his
7 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
8 subsections 4(1)(a), 4(1)(j), 4(2)(f), 4(2)(j), 4(2)(k),
9 4(2)(l), 4(2)(m), 4(2)(r), 4(2)(x), 4(3)(m) and 4(2)(n)
10 of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
11 Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated
12 under subsection 4(2)(i) of this act shall be the
13 Secretary of the Department of Education or her
14 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
15 subsection 4(2)(o) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Port
16 Authority (PPA); the allottee of funds appropriated
17 under subsections 4(2)(w), 4(2)(q) and 4(2)(z) of this
18 act shall be the Mayor of Sapwuahfik Municipal
19 Government or his designee, the allottee of funds
20 appropriated under subsections 4(2)(ac) and 4(2)(ad) of
21 this act shall be the Sokehs Municipal Government; the
22 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
23 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk
24 State or his designee; the allottee of the funds
25 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be

1 the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the
2 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(3)
3 of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal
4 Government or his designee; the allottee of the funds
5 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be
6 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the
7 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5)
8 of this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.
9 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
10 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,
11 2025.”

12 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
13 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
14 becoming law without such approval.
