## AN ACT

To appropriate \$67,903,100 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The purpose of this act is to Purpose. 2 appropriate the sum of \$67,903,100 from the General Fund of the 3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending 4 September 30, 2018, for the purpose of funding the operations of 5 all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of 6 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and 7 contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development. The 8 National Government's share of the Amended Compact funds has been 9 reduced to zero; EXCEPT THAT; the National Government will retain 10 10 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is 11 reflected in the budget for the Department of Education. The sum 12 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:

Allotment and Management of Funds and Lapse

## (1) General provisions.

(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance
with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the

1 Financial Management Act of 1979.

(b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring 2 that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are 3 used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no 4 obligations are incurred in excess of the sums appropriated. 5 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds appropriated 6 by this act are as follows: 7 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall be 8 9 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia; (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall be 10 11 the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia; 12 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall be 13 the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated States of 14 Micronesia; (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall be 15 16 the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia; (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these 17 18 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of 19 Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following subsections 20 of sections 8 through 9 of this act: 21 (i) Section 8(1)(g) - the allottee of these funds 22 shall be the Chair of the Joint Committee on Compact Review and 23 Planning; (ii) Section 8(9) - the allottee of these funds 24 25 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of

1 Micronesia;

2 (iii) Section 8(12)(a) - the allottee of these 3 funds shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM; 4 (iv) Section 8(12)(e) through (h) - the allottee 5 of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the respective State 6 Supreme Court; 7 (v) Section 9(1) - the allottee of these funds 8 shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM. (vi) Section 9(16)(f) - the allottee of these 9 10 funds shall be the Governor of the State of Yap. 11 (3) Lapse date.
