5 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 21-178, as amended
 6 by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102, 21-115,
 7 21-137, 21-165, 21-178, 21-200, 21-206, 21-218, 21-226, 21-249,
 8 22-63, 22-138, 22-138 and 22-145, is hereby further amended to
 9 read as follows:

10 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 11 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 12 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 13 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 14 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 15 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 16 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
 17 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
 18 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
 19 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
 20 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
 21 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
 22 appropriated under sections 3(a) to 3(as) of this act
 23 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
 24 designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
 25 appropriated under subsections 3(ad) and 4(2)(q) of this

1 act shall be the President of COM-FSM; the allottee of
2 funds appropriated under subsection 3(al) of this act
3 shall be the Secretary of the FSM Department of
4 Education or his designee. The allottee of funds
5 appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the
6 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
7 designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
8 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(c) of this act shall
9 be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the allottee of
10 funds appropriated under section 4(1) and subsection
11 4(3)(w) of this act shall be the Vice President of the
12 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the
13 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
14 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(c) of this act shall be the
15 Secretary of the Department of Health and Social Affairs
16 or her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated
17 under subsections 4(3)(d), 4(3)(y) and 4(3)(z) of this
18 act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
19 Education or his designee; the allottee of funds
20 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(ab), 4(4)(f) and
21 4(3)(p) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
22 Authority, the funds appropriated under subsection
23 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the President of the
24 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, the
25 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(x)

1 of this act shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of
2 Madolenihmw Municipal Government or his designee; the
3 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(i), 4(3)(j) of
4 this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
5 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his
6 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
7 subsection 4(3)(ae) of this act shall be the Secretary
8 of the Department of Resources and Development or his
9 designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
10 subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the
11 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee, EXCEPT THAT the
12 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(6)(a)
13 of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
14 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his
15 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
16 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks
17 Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of
18 funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act
19 shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his
20 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
21 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern
22 Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the
23 funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act
24 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The

1 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated
2 by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2026.”

3 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
4 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
5 becoming law without such approval.
