

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-60, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-65, 20-75, 20-85, 20-97, 20-150, 21-69, 21-84, 21-100, 21-129, 21-163, 21-173, 21-187, 22-11, 22-59, 22-78 and 22-132, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and extend the lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs in Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 20-60, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 20-65, 20-85, 20-150, 21-60, 21-84, 22-11, 22-59
3 and 22-123, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the \$4,450,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$1,800,000 shall be apportioned for public projects
6 and social programs in the state of Chuuk.

15 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-60, as
 16 amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-65, 20-75, 20-97, 21-129,
 17 21-163, 21-173, 22-78 and 22-132, is hereby further amended
 18 to read as follows:

19 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 20 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 21 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 22 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 23 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 24 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 25 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used

1 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
2 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
3 appropriated. The allottee of funds appropriated under
4 section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State
5 or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
6 appropriated under subsections 2(i), 2(j) and 2(n) of
7 this act shall be the President or his designee. The
8 allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 3 and
9 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated
10 States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the
11 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(a) to
12 3(o) and subsection 3(af) of this act shall be the Mayor
13 of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the allottee of
14 funds appropriated under subsections 3(p) to 3(ae) of
15 this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his
16 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
17 subsections 4(1)(m) and 4(1)(o) of this act shall be the
18 Mayor of Pingelap or his designee; the allottee of funds
19 appropriated under subsections 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g) and
20 4(2)(m) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
21 Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated
22 under subsection 4(2)(o) of this act shall be the
23 Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC). The allottee of the
24 funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of
25 this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his

1 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
2 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks
3 Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of
4 funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act
5 shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his
6 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
7 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern
8 Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the
9 funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act
10 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The
11 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated
12 by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2026.”

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1 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
