PUBLIC LAW NO. 20-154

AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 8, and 9 of Public Law No. 20-131, to appropriate \$3,752,343 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, to provide funding for the operations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-131 is hereby

2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to appropriate the sum of \$68,572,270 from the General Fund 4 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal 5 6 year ending September 30, 2019, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the National 7 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its 8 9 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and 10 contributions and Capital and Human Resources 11 Development. The National Government's share of the 12 Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT 13 THAT; the National Government will retain the Compact Sector Grant amount for COM-FSM and 10 percent of the 14 15 Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in 16 the budget for the Department of Education.
