

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53 and 21-56, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36 and 21-53, 21-56 and 21-90,  
3 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4. Of the \$9,800,000 appropriated under this  
5 act, \$2,800,000 shall be apportioned for public projects  
6 and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State.

10 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by  
 11 Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-36, 21-53 and 21-56, is hereby further  
 12 amended to read as follows:

13 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
 14 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
 15 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
 16 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
 17 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
 18 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
 19 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
 20 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
 21 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
 22 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
 23 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap  
 24 State or his designee. The allottee of funds  
 25 appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the

1 Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT  
2 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
3 3(ad) of this act and 4(2)(q) shall be the President of  
4 COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds  
5 appropriated under subsections 3(ae) to 3(ak) of this  
6 act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his  
7 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
8 subsection 3(al) of this act shall be the Secretary of  
9 the FSM Department of Education or his designee. The  
10 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this  
11 act shall be the President of the Federated States of  
12 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee  
13 of funds appropriated under section 4(1) and subsection  
14 4(3)(w) of this act shall be the Vice President of the  
15 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the  
16 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
17 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(c) of this act shall be the  
18 Secretary of the Department of Health and Social Affairs  
19 or her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated  
20 under subsections 4(3)(d), 4(3)(y) and 4(3)(z) of this  
21 act shall be the Secretary of the Department of  
22 Education or his designee; the allottee of funds  
23 appropriated under subsections 4(4)(f) and 4(3)(p) of  
24 this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority,  
25 the funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(g) of this

1 act shall be the President of the Federated States of  
2 Micronesia or his designee, the allottee of funds  
3 appropriated under subsection 4(3)(x) of this act shall  
4 be the Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw Municipal  
5 Government or his designee; the funds appropriated under  
6 subsections 4(3)(i), 4(3)(j) and 5(6)(a) of this act  
7 shall be the Secretary of the Department of  
8 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his  
9 designee; The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
10 subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this act shall be the  
11 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of  
12 the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act  
13 shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority  
14 (MIDA); the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
15 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern  
16 Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the  
17 funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act  
18 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The  
19 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated  
20 by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2020.”
