PUBLIC LAW NO. 21-241

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 21-201, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-219 and 21-229, by amending sections 3, 4 and 5 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund priority infrastructure projects and other public projects and social programs for the people of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 21-201, as amended by
