

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-125, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-135, 20-146, 20-157, 20-179, 20-189, 21-06, 21-40 and 21-59, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the states of Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 20-125, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 20-135, 20-146, 20-157 and 21-40, is hereby
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4. Of the \$7,000,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$2,000,000 shall be apportioned for public projects
6 and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State.

1 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-125, as amended by
2 Public Law Nos. 20-135, 20-157, 20-179 and 21-40, is hereby
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
5 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
6 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
7 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
8 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
9 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
10 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
11 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
12 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
13 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
14 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
15 State or his designee. The allottee of the funds
16 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be
17 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
18 his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
19 appropriated under subsection 3(o) of this act shall be
20 the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee, the
21 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(b) to
22 3(q) and 3(u) to 3(z) of this act shall be the Mayor of
23 Lelu Town Government or his designee; the allottee of
24 funds appropriated under subsections 3(a), 3(r), 3(s)
25 and 3(t) of this act shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak

1 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
2 funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(v) of this act
3 shall be the Meninkeder lapalap of Madolenihmw Municipal
4 Government or his designee; the allottee of funds
5 appropriated under subsection 4(1)(w) of this act shall
6 be the Chief Minister of U Municipal Government or his
7 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
8 subsection 4(1)(x) of this act shall be the District
9 Administrator of Nett Municipal Government or his
10 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
11 subsection 4(1)(y) of this act shall be the Luhken
12 Menlap of Kitti Municipal Government or his designee;
13 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
14 4(2)(w) and 4(1)(z) of this act shall be the Chief
15 Magistrate of Sokehs Municipal Government or his
16 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
17 subsections 4(2)(a) to 4(2)(v) of this act shall be the
18 Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
19 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the
20 allottee of fund appropriated under subsections 4(1)(a2)
21 and 4(4)(m) of this act shall be the Mayor of Pingelap
22 Municipal Government; the allottee of funds appropriated
23 under subsections 4(1)(a1) and 4(4)(n) of this act shall
24 be the Chief Magistrate of Mwoakilloa Municipal
25 Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under

1 subsection 4(1)(a3) of this act shall be the Luhken
2 Kolwof of Sapuwafik Municipal Government; the allottee
3 of funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(a4) of this
4 act shall be the Mayor of Nukuoro Municipal Government;
5 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
6 4(1)(a5) of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of
7 Kapingamarangi Municipal Government. The allottee of
8 funds appropriated under subsection 4(4)(b) of this act
9 shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA). The
10 allottee of the funds appropriated sections 5 of this
11 act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
12 designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
13 appropriated under subsections 5(h) and 5(j) of this act
14 shall be the FSM Telecommunication Corporation or its
15 designee. The authority of the allottee to obligate
16 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
17 30, 2021".

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1 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
