

TWENTY-FIRST CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

THIRD REGULAR SESSION, 2020 CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 21-133, C.D.1, C.D.2

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AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53 and 21-56, by amending sections 3, 4 and 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-53 and 21,56, is hereby amended  
3 to read as follows:

4           "Section 3. Of the \$9,800,000 appropriated under  
5 this act, \$1,400,000 shall be apportioned for  
6 public projects and social programs for the people  
7 of Kosrae State.

22 Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by  
 23 Public Laws Nos. 21-01 and 21-36, 21-53 and 21-56, is hereby  
 24 amended to read as follows:

1           "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
2           date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
3           allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
4           accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
5           limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
6           allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
7           funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
8           solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
9           no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
10          appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
11          under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap  
12          State or his designee. The allottee of funds  
13          appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the  
14          Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT  
15          the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
16          3(ad) of this act and 4(2)(q) shall be the President of  
17          COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds  
18          appropriated under subsections 3(ae) to 3(ak) of this  
19          act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his  
20          designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
21          subsection 3(al) of this act shall be the Secretary of  
22          the FSM Department of Education or his designee. The  
23          allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this  
24          act shall be the President of the Federated States of  
25          Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee

1 of funds appropriated under section 4(1) and subsection  
2 4(3)(w) of this act shall be the Vice President of the  
3 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; allottee  
4 of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(v) of this  
5 act shall be the Mayor of Kolonia Town Government or his  
6 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
7 subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(c) of this act  
8 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health and  
9 Social Affairs or her designee; the allottee of funds  
10 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d), 4(3)(y) and  
11 4(3)(z) of this act shall be the Secretary of the  
12 Department of Education or his designee; the allottee of  
13 funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(u), 4(4)(f),  
14 4(3)(p) and 4(3)(ab) of this act shall be the Pohnpei  
15 Transportation Authority; the funds appropriated under  
16 subsection 4(3)(ac) of this act shall be Lukenmenlap of  
17 Kitti; the funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(g)  
18 of this act shall be the President of the Federated  
19 States of Micronesia or his designee, the allottee of  
20 funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(x) of this act  
21 shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw Municipal  
22 Government or his designee; the funds appropriated under  
23 subsections 4(3)(i) and 4(3)(j) of this act shall be the  
24 Secretary of the Department of Transportation,  
25 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; The

1 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections  
2 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of  
3 Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of the funds  
4 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be  
5 the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the  
6 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4)  
7 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development  
8 Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
9 subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk  
10 Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to  
11 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on  
12 September 30, 2020."

13 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
14 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
15 becoming law without such approval.
