

AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 6, 7, 8 and 12 of Public Law No. 21-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-55 and 21-77, to deappropriate \$299,782 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia, in order to prioritize the nation's interests in light of the coronavirus epidemic, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, from the operations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, Office of the National Public Auditor, Agencies of the National Government, Special Programs, Grants, Subsidies and Contributions, and to change the allottee of certain funds; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 21-42, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 21-55 and 21-77, is hereby further amended to  
3 read as follows:

4           "Purpose. The purpose of this act is to appropriate the  
5 sum of \$71,508,570 from the General Fund of the  
6 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year  
7 ending September 30, 2020, for the purpose of funding  
8 the operations of all branches of the National  
9 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its  
10 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and  
11 contributions and Capital and Human Resources  
12 Development. The National Government's share of the  
13 Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT  
14 THAT; the National Government will retain the Compact  
15 Sector Grant amount for COM-FSM and 10 percent of the  
16 Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in

1 the budget for the Department of Education. The sum  
2 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:"

3 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Laws Nos. 21-42, as amended

13 Section 6. Section 12 of Public Law No. 21-42, as amended by  
 14 Public Laws Nos. 21-55 and 21-77, is hereby further amended to  
 15 read as follows:

16 “Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and  
 17 Lapse Dates.

18 (1) General provisions.

19 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
 20 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
 21 accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
 22 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

23 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for  
 24 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be  
 25 necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in



1           this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess  
2           of the sums appropriated.

3           (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds  
4           appropriated by this act are as follows:

5                   (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall  
6           be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

7                   (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall  
8           be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States  
9           of Micronesia;

10                   (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall  
11           23 of 26 be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of  
12           the Federated States of Micronesia;

13                   (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall  
14           be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of  
15           Micronesia;

16                   (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these  
17           funds shall be the President of the Federated States of  
18           Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following  
19           subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:

20                           (i) Sections 8(1)(f) and 8(13)(q) - the  
21           allottee of these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint  
22           Committee on Compact Review and Planning;

23                           (ii) Section 8(8)(a) - the allottee of these  
24           funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;

25                           (iii) Section 8(8)(b) - the allottee of these

1 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;

2 (iv) Section 8(8)(c) – the allottee of these  
3 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

4 (v) Section 8(8)(d) – the allottee of these  
5 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;

6 (vi) Section 8(11) – the allottee of these funds  
7 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of  
8 Micronesia;

9 (vii) Section 8(12) – the allottee of these funds  
10 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated;  
11 States of Micronesia;

12 (viii) Section 8(13)(a) – the allottee of these  
13 funds shall be the President of the College of  
14 Micronesia-FSM;

15 (ix) Section 8(13)(d) through (g) – the  
16 allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of  
17 the respective State Supreme Court;

18 (x) Section 8(13)(h) – the allottee of these  
19 funds shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of  
20 the Federated States of Micronesia

21 (xi) Section 9(1) – the allottee of these funds  
22 shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM;

23 (xii) Section 9(3)(b) – the allottee of these  
24 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;

25 (xiii) Section 9(3)(c) – the allottee of these

1 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;

2 (xiv) Section 9(3)(d) – the allottee of these

3 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

4 (xv) Section 9(3)(e) – the allottee of these

5 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;

6 (xvi) Section 9(12)(b) – the allottee of these

7 funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the

8 Federated States of Micronesia;

9 (xvii) Section 9(12)(f) and 9(12)(g) – the allottee

10 of these funds shall be the Secretary of Department of

11 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure;

12 (xviii) Section 8(13)(t) – the allottee of these

13 funds shall be the National Olympic Committee;

14 (xix) Section 8(13)(u) – the allottee of these

15 funds shall be the Principal of Saint Cecilia Catholic

16 School;

17 (xx) Section 9(12)(d) – the allottee of these

18 funds shall be the President of the Constitutional

19 Convention.

20 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to

21 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall

22 lapse as of September 30, 2020; PROVIDED,

23 HOWEVER, that the funds appropriated under

24 section 9 of this act shall not lapse.”

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1           Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.
