AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$2,800,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE I	T ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
1	Section 1. The sum of \$2,800,000, or so much thereof as may
2	be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
3	Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
4	September 30, 2022, for the purpose of funding public projects and
5	social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk
6	states. The funds appropriated under this section shall be
7	apportioned as follows:

13	All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
14	administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,
15	including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
16	1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
17	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
18	the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are
19	incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the
20	funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the
21	Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds
22	appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the
23	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
24	EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under section 3(1)
25	of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee;

- 1 the allottee of funds appropriated under section 3(2) of this act
- 2 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the
- 3 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)a, 4(1)(b),
- 4 4(1)(c), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(i) and 4(3)(c)
- 5 of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
- 6 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his designee;
- 7 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(c) and
- 8 4(3)(b) of this act shall be the Secretary of Health and Social
- 9 Affairs or her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
- 10 subsection 4(2)(e) of this act shall be the President of COM-FSM;
- 11 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(f) of
- 12 this act shall be the FSM NOC; the allottee of funds appropriated
- 13 under subsections 4(1)(d), 4(1)(e), 4(2)(h) of this act shall be
- 14 the Secretary of the Department of Education or his designee; the
- 15 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(d),
- 16 4(3)(e), 4(3)(f) and 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
- 17 Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated
- 18 under subsections 4(3)(h) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility
- 19 Corporation (PUC). The allottee of the funds appropriated under
- 20 subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of
- 21 Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of the funds
- 22 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the
- 23 Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the
- 24 funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the
- 25 Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee

1	of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall
2	be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of
3	the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be
4	the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the allottee
5	to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
6	September 30, 2024.
7	Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
8	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
9	becoming law without such approval.
