PUBLIC LAW NO. 23-09

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-187, 22-188 and 23-03, by amending sections 2, 4 and 5 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people Yap, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
